The passenger figures have definitely stabilised, with a small increase (1.5% incl transit) for the 3rd month in a row. Interestingly Domestic passengers dropped 19% but international scheduled increased by 9.2%. Even Charter passengers only declined by 2.9%, the lowest year on year decline since May 2008 (except June 2010). The decline in Terminal 2 usage continues and for the 2nd month T3 had more passengers than T2. Movements have also shown a small increase for the 2nd month. The freight figures have also rebounded with a 11.6% increase compared to December 2009.
