The passenger figures show no sign of improvement, in fact, the reduction of 14.1% (incl Transit) when compared to January 2009, is the largest year-on-year reduction since March 2009. The Moving Annual total of 18.6 million is down to the levels last seen in 2000. HOWEVER, the freight figures show an excellent year on year INCREASE of 14.5%, and the MAT is now only -24.4% down when compared to a year ago and was -33.7% at the peak of the decline. Will the passenger figures follow the freight figures?
