The downward trend continues. Interestingly these figures are very similar to the May ones, with a 13 % reduction in passengers when compared to June 2008. This months passenger figures (including Transit) are around the figure last seen in 1999. For only three years in the last 17 years (1993, 1995 & 1996) has the freight tonnage been lower than this month's figures in June. The moving annual total is now around the level seen in 2002/3/4 before the surge in traffic numbers. Not good reading!
