The downturn in Passengers, Movement and Freight continues. An 18% reduction in passengers over March 2008 is extradinary, and the only positive aspect I can find is that the Easter Holidays fell fully in March last year, so this April figures shouldn't be quite as bad as these. The most startling figure is the reduction in Charter passengers of just over 30% over last year, which accounted for just 25% of the total for the month. Four years ago the number of Charter traffic passengers stood at 506,730, which means there has been a 34% reduction since March 2005.
