The passenger numbers increased by 10% in May when compared to a year ago, which is a sound performance, but it is difficult to draw any conclusions as May 2010 was also affected by the ash cloud. The number of passengers using Terminal 3 increased significantly (+24.4%) and charter passengers and movements seem to have stabilised as they are almost the same as last year. Now the summer season has commenced more passengers went through Terminal 2 compared to Terminal 3. The freight figures are disappointing with a reduction of 15.7%. June's figures will be a better indicator of how well the airport is really doing.
