The year on year passenger figures for September are very slighter better than August's (-9.4% incl transit compared to -10%). A sobering thought though is that the monthly passenger figure for September 2009 was about the same as for September 1998. HOWEVER, the freight Moving Annual Total has moved in the right direction when compared to the previous month for the first time since April 2008, however don't get carried away as it is still down 33% from a year ago.
